Song/Story: Humpty Dumpty **Color:** Purple

Visual Skills / Literacy

Egg cartons for sorting
Fitting things together, i.e. eggshell toys
APH "Roly Poly Man" book
Holding "all the pieces" in our arms
On the Light Table:
*Raw eggs in plastic bags to poke
*Purple goo
Building with wooden blocks
Grape stomping!
Tactile Humpty Dumpty picture
Braille board "H" and "D"

Motor skills / O & M

Obstacle Course: Add foam shapes to build a wall
Plastic eggs
*Line up eggs along the wall
*Roll eggs down the incline bolster
*Roll our bodies down the incline bolster
Practice "falling" safely
Walking on a low wall
Riding horses

Communication / Music

Following directions –All Fall down
Concepts of On/Off, Wet /Dry
Broken / Breakable "All"
Movement Songs: Up/Down and Falling off
Rhythm with hands on drums using "Rhythmic
Speech Cueing" to say nursery rhymes
Insert single words or word approximations
*Use of egg shakers w/ dropping or throwing
them into the drum
*Use of egg shakers on different body parts

Sensory / Socialization

Play with powdered grape Jello and cool whip
Plastic eggs in the sensory table to fill with
corn, knock off the edge
Push raw eggs along the ground with a spoon
Pass raw eggs "carefully" to each other at the
table.

Snack

Oval Shapes / Egg shapes
Purple juice
Grapes, cut up
Grape jello
Grape suckers
Grape letter sticks
Eggs—hard boiled, scrambled
*Cracking a hard-boiled egg
